


Denis Kravchenko, State Duma Deputy: "Excellent Forum, great exhibition, we opened it and made an official exhibition tour with pleasure. A lot of interesting innovations. ROSATOM today is really strengthening in the minds of ordinary people, and politicians, and scientists that in whatever he undertook, he does it at the highest technological level. The same applies to environmental issues. Nuclear energy more and more is associated with environmental friendliness.

Claudio Peskatore, doctor of technical Sciences of University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, professor of University of Linnaeus (Sweden): "AtomEco Conference was interesting for the understanding of the situation in Russia. It is very important that people have the opportunity to think about the participation of society in technological development and how it occurs in Europe, considering all our mistakes."

Alan Khasiyev, Chairman of the coordinating Council of the Interregional ecological movement "Oka", expert of the State Duma of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation: "AtomEco Forum is very interesting for us. The fact that in the framework of our work when we conduct our environmental studies, we not only learn and gather information, but also bring it to the public and formulate suggestions for ROSATOM. These propositions concern, primarily, environmental safety and issues of radioactive waste management. In this sense, we find full understanding. In addition, we actively participate in the discussion of the annual reports of the largest companies of ROSATOM.
